MatCalc licenses - Overview



Persistent licenses

Persistent licenses have to interact with our main license activation server (activation.mceng.at:60100) at least once to be activated for a particular computer.

Transient licenses

Transient (network) licenses are licenses that can be temporarily activated and which are deactivated automatically after prolonged non-use. Network licenses require the installation of a local server to manage the regular activations and deactivations of the license. They are characterized by a subnetwork address in which they are valid, and a maximum number of concurrent users. Within the given subnetwork, any computer that has MatCalc installed and is able to connect to the local server can use MatCalc.



Activation of **Persistent licenses**(Single-User-Single-Node / Multi-User-Multi-Node licenses)






- Download the license file from the MatCalc Engineering GmbH customer portal: https://customers.matcalc-engineering.com
- Move the corresponding license file into your "matcalc_user_data/licenses/*" directory that you have created or selected before.






- Close and restart MatCalc

- Press the "Activate License" button





Activation of Persistent licenses




Retrieval of **Transient licenses** (Network licenses)


- Start MatCalc

- Click on "Settings"








- Click on "Licenses" in the "Options" window
- Press the "Retrieve NW license" button








- Establish a connection with your local license server
- Press the "Add" button








- Enter your local license server IP or the hostname
